What is Police Artist?

Police Artist is a set of libraries grouped by facial shapes such as noses, chins, creases, etc.

It works as a police artist who would review an eyewitness to ask for different topographical elements of the face to form a whole that can be used for facial recognition. With 280 shapes it is easy to find the fitting ones.

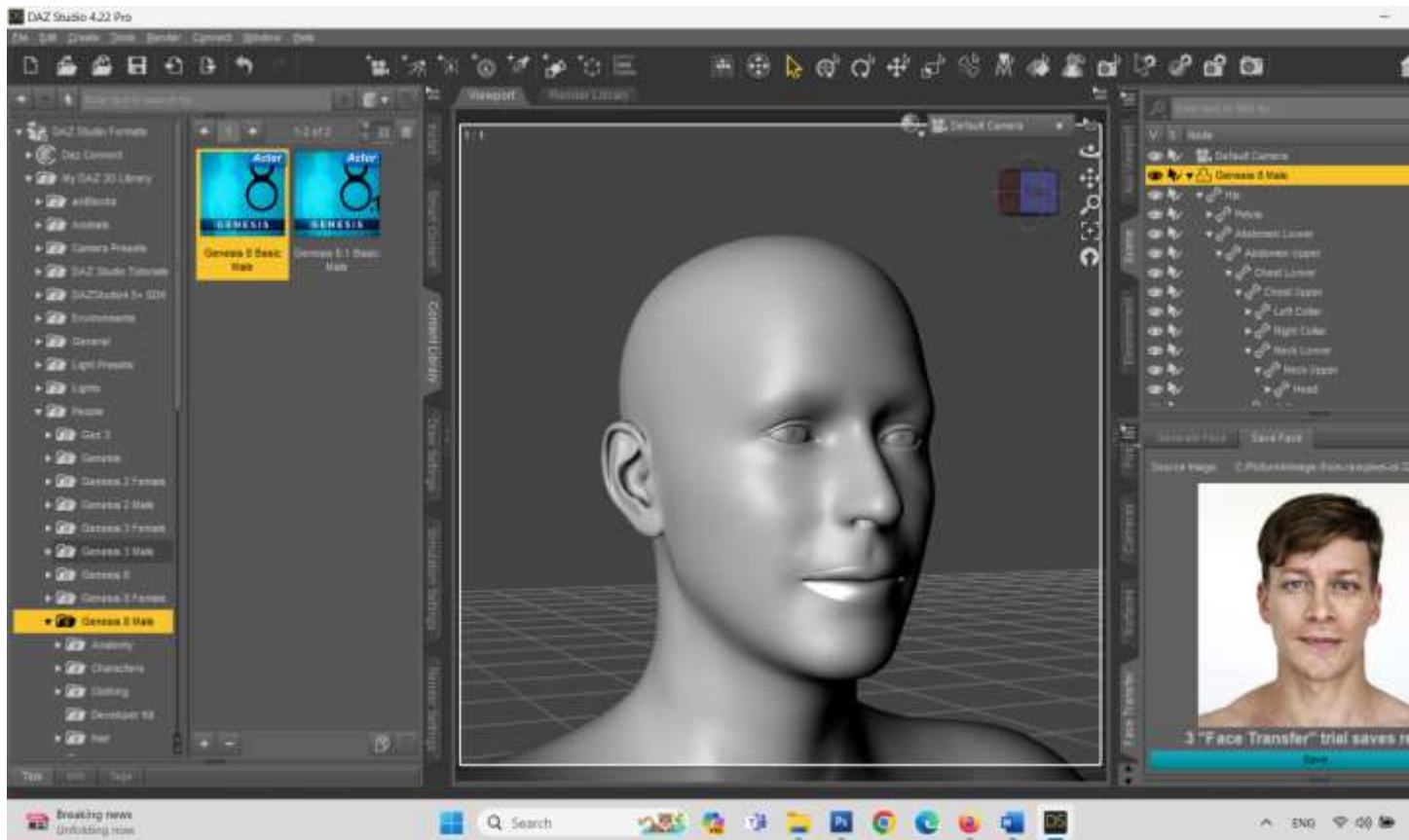
When Do You Use Police Artist?

A good example is the use in conjunction with “Photo-to-3D Head” software such as Face Transfer or FaceGen.

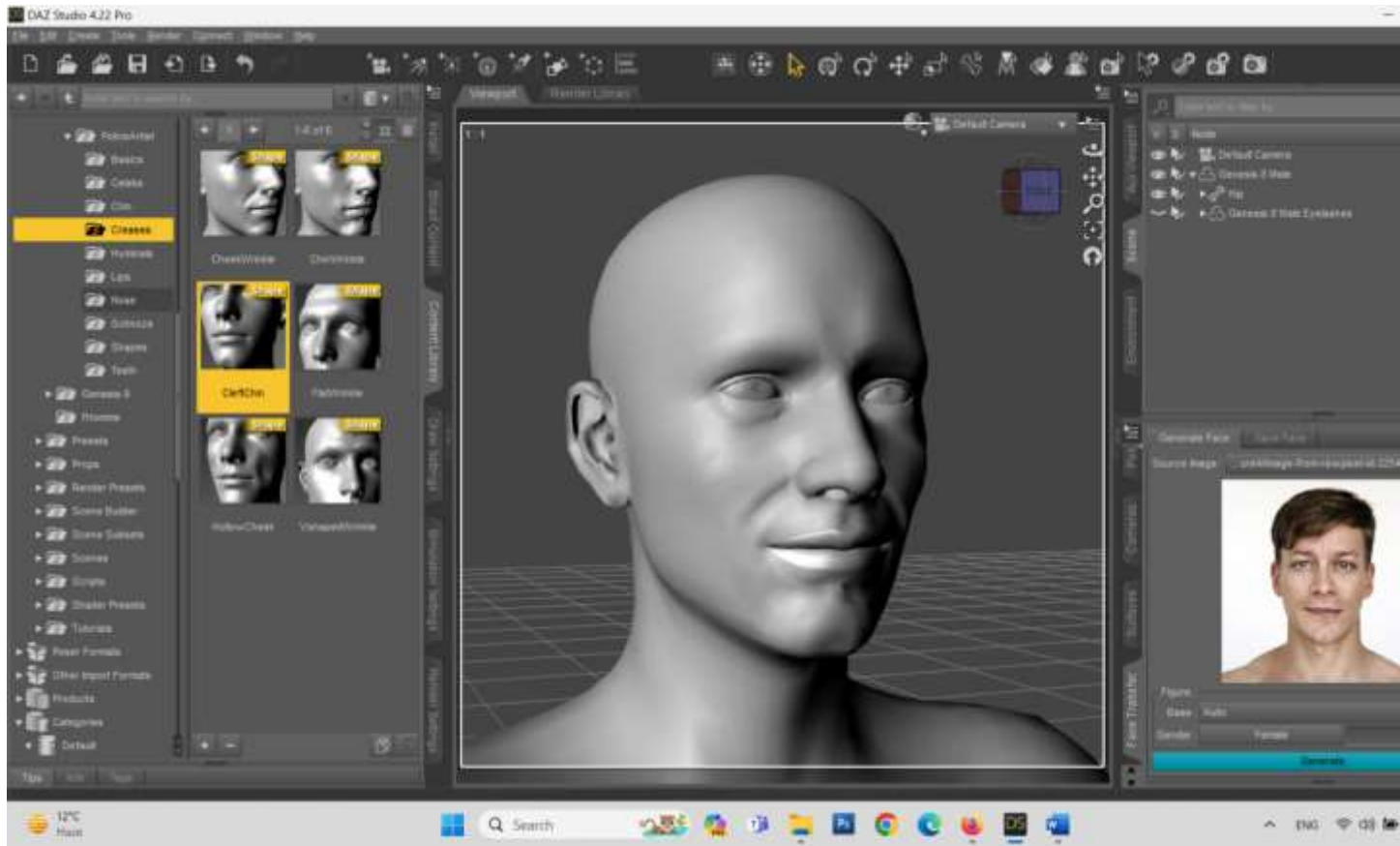
While they are good at texture mapping, they lack good topographical shapes to fit the texture.

Here’s a practical sample, using Face Transfer and a random photo.

When turning off the texture, the shapes on the face are lacking



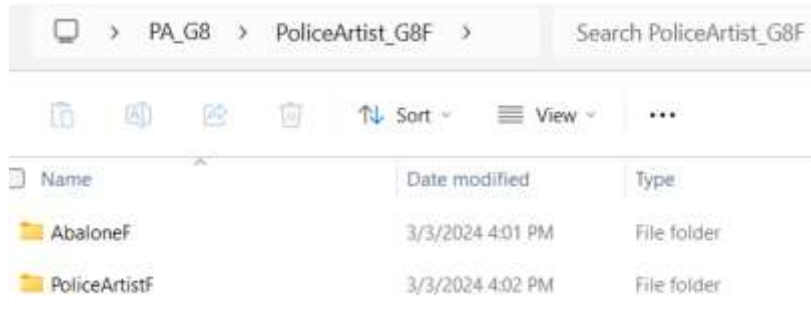
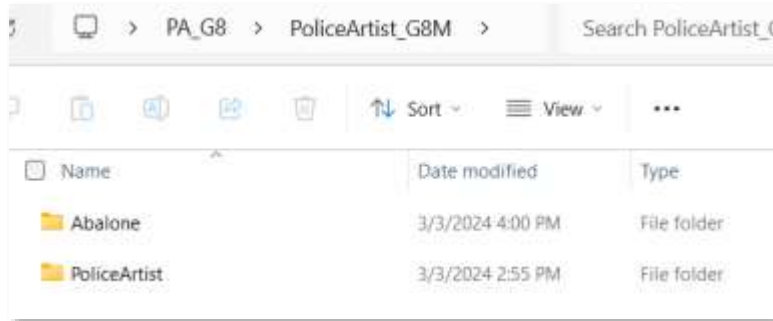
With using Police Artist, it is easy to add facial topography as shown below



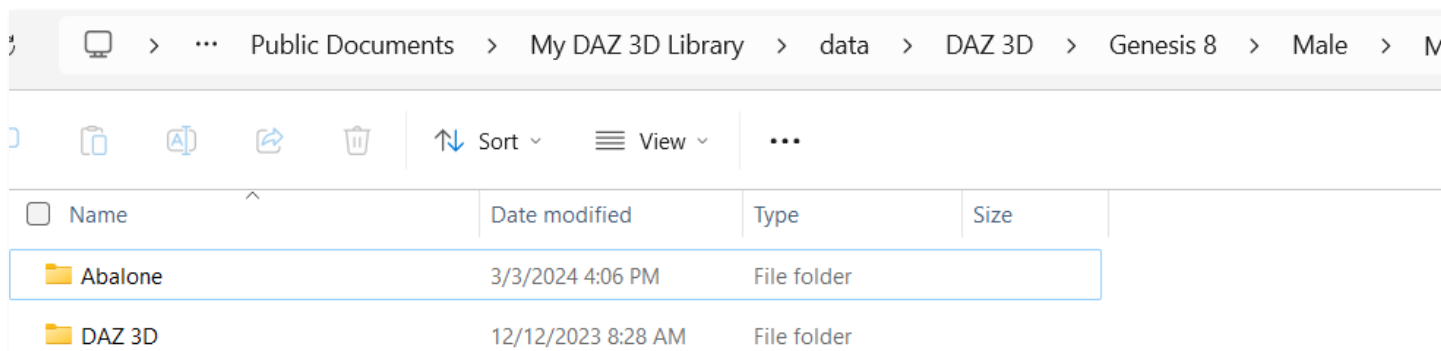
Manual Installation

Police Artist needs two folders to install. After unzipping the downloaded file, in Police Artist for Gen 8 you find two folders for Genesis 8

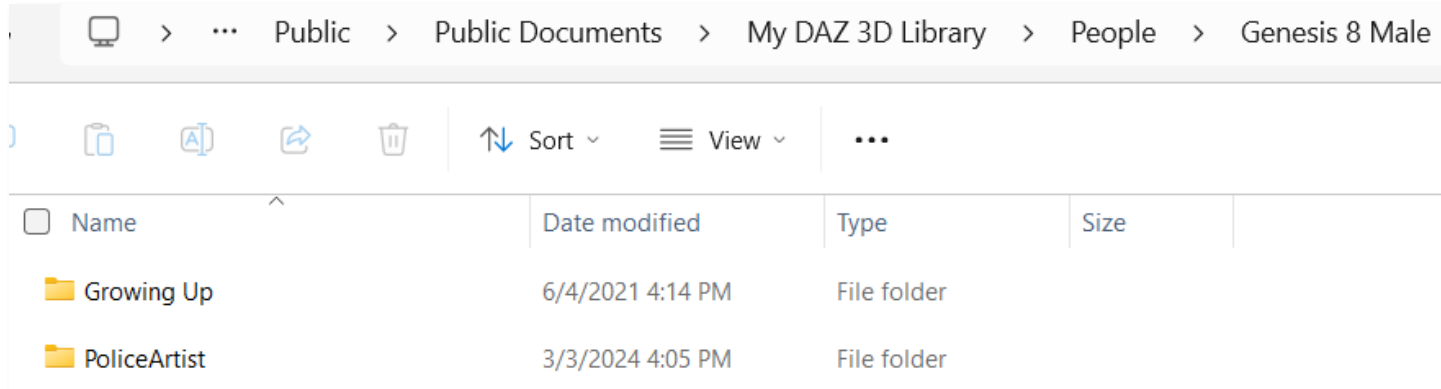
Male and Female. Inside each you will have two folders that needs to be copy/pasted: Abalone and PoliceArtist in **G8M**, and AbaloneF and PoliceArtistF in **G8F**



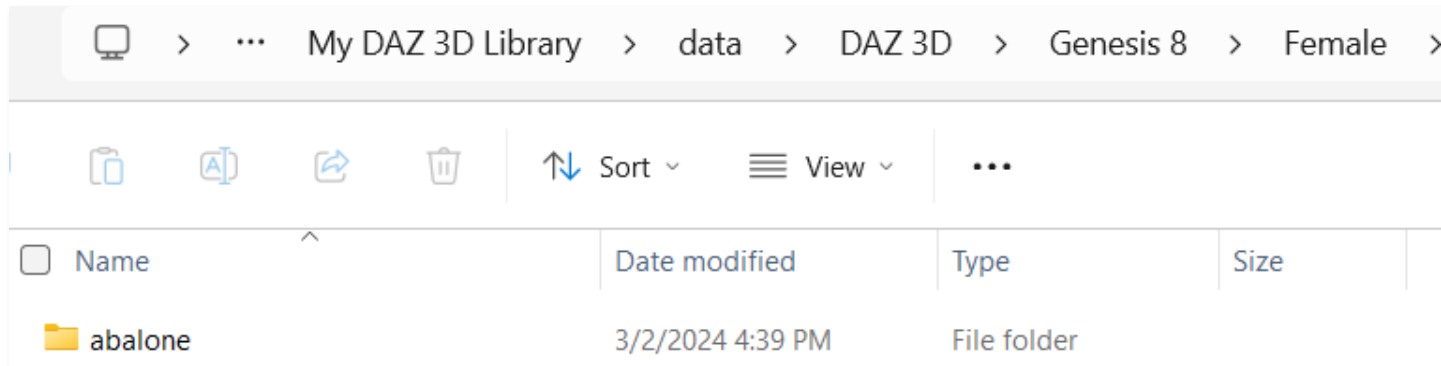
FOR G8 (Male): Copy/Paste **PoliceArtist_G8M/Abalone** to **User/Public/Public Documents/My DAZ 3D Library/data/DAZ 3D/Genesis 8/Male/Morphs**



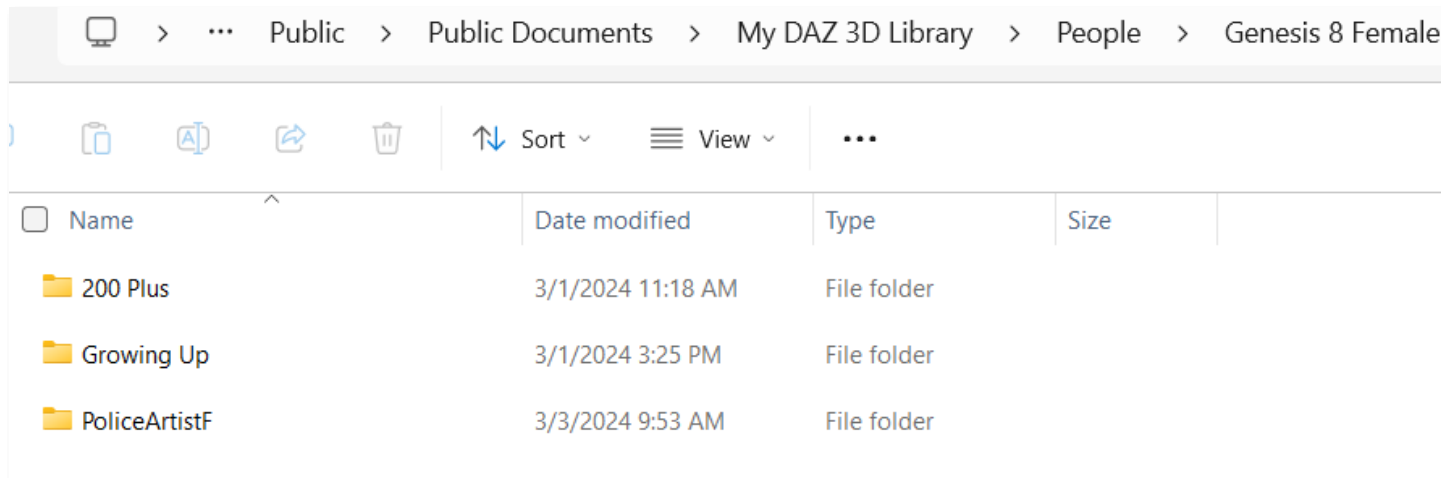
Copy/Paste **PoliceArtist_G8M/PoliceArtist** to **User/Public/Public Documents/My DAZ 3D Library/People/Genesis 8 Male/Shapes**



FOR G8F (Female): Copy/Paste **PoliceArtist_G8F/Abalone** to **User/Public/Public Documents/My DAZ 3D Library/data/DAZ 3D/Genesis 8/Female/Morphs**



Copy/Paste **PoliceArtist_G8F/PoliceArtistF** to **User/Public/Public Documents/My DAZ 3D Library/People/Genesis 8 Female/Shapes**
